



**Disclosure of Notifiable Gift**  
(Regulation 34B  
Local Government (Administration) Regulations 1996)

**Notes:**

1. A notifiable gift is a gift or act of hospitality valued between \$50 and \$300.
2. Gifts from relatives are excluded.
3. Gifts exceeding \$300 in value are prohibited.
4. Two or more Notifiable gifts from the same person within a six month period are prohibited if the total value exceeds \$300.
5. Common sense dictates that reciprocal acts of hospitality or giving between friends are excluded.
6. If in doubt, consult the Chief Executive Officer.
